

# Summary of Funerals Logged

- \* Between April 29, 1903 and January 12, 1907, Undertaker Zercher recorded railroad-related deaths of 87 laborers and 13 of their children.
- \* Of the deceased migrant workers and their children, he identified 31 as Italian, 25 as Slavish, 2 as Slavish/Austrian, 2 as Austrian, 2 as German, 2 as Irish, 1 as Hungarian, 1 as English, 1 as Polish. He did not note a nationality for the remaining. (*Lancaster New Era* identified the 11 who perished on June 6, 1906 as American.)
- \* He identified 18 by both name and payroll number, 61 by name only, 2 by payroll number only, and 19 by neither.
- \* He noted the age of the youngest deceased laborer as 17, and the oldest as 75. The median age was 25.5 years; the mean was 29 years.
- \* Of the 40 laborers whose age he noted, the most common age was 20, with a count of 6. Four were 22 years old when they died, 3 were 28, and 3 were 35 years old.
- \* His burial charges ranged from \$10 for the youngest infants to \$76 for the most difficult corpse.
- \* Among the 89 deceased whose burial expenses he noted, he charged \$35 for each of 27 laborers' funerals; he charged \$40 for each of 12 funerals. His clients paid \$3212 total for the care of the 89.
- \* He aggregated the funeral costs to \$350 for the 11 workers who perished in a single dynamite blast on June 9, 1906. (He buried the body parts of 10 of those in a single coffin.)
- \* He noted that burial expenses for 82 deceased laborers were paid by the H.S. Kerbaugh Co.; expenses for 5 were paid by Charles A. Sims Co.; and expenses for 11 were paid by an assortment of countrymen and friends of the deceased. For 3 funerals he did not say or imply who paid the costs.
- \* Of the 97 remains whose final resting place he noted, he buried 46 at Safe Harbor Catholic Cemetery and 26 at Conestoga Mt. Zion Cemetery. He buried 10 at Colemanville M.E. Cemetery. At the request of families, he sent other bodies to Washington, D.C., Fredericksburg, VA, and these Pennsylvania locations--Hollidaysburg, Wellsboro, Muncy, Steelton (2), Hazelton, and Columbia (2). He buried 4 in Lancaster (1 in St. Joseph Cemetery, and 1 in St. Mary's Cemetery). Finally, S.C. Stevenson 'took charge of' one body.
